REPORT ON AGS HEALTH SERVICE Pre- Placement Training cum Placement drive

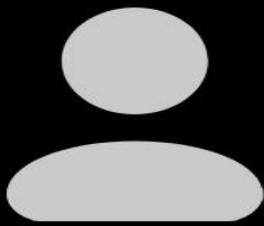

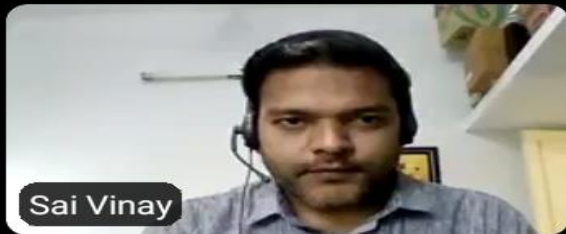

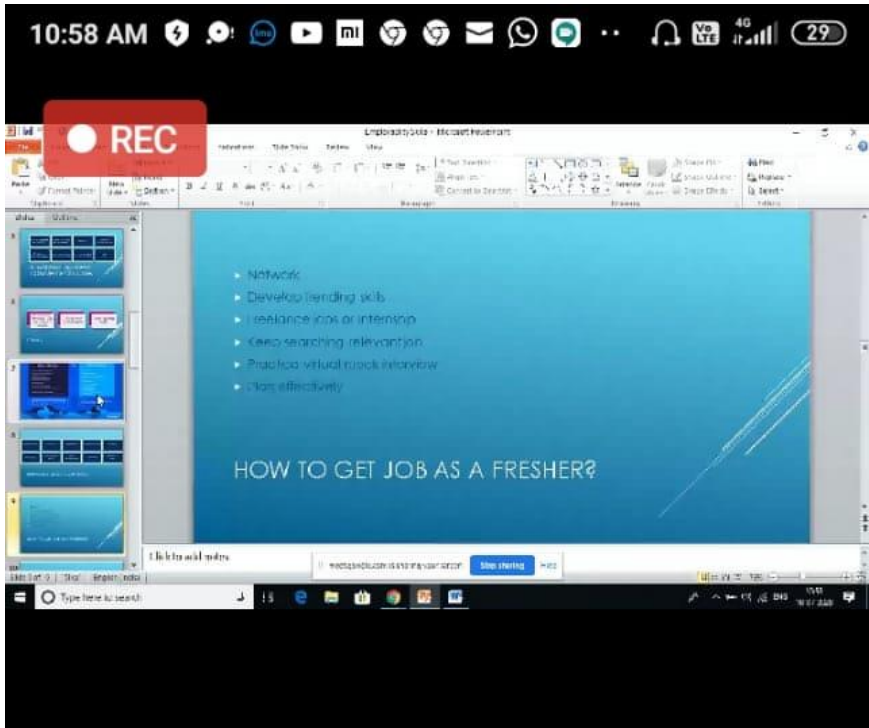
Webinar Report on

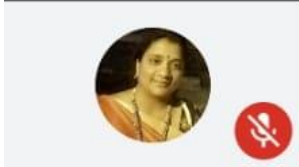
