

# **BRIDGE COURSE**

## **2018- 2019**

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In keeping with the tradition of the college, a Bridge Course for the first years was conducted for three days from 18. 06. 2018 to 20.06.2018. The aim of the Bridge course is to ensure a smooth transition from school education to collegiate education and a general brush up of communication and soft skills. Ms V. P. Gayathri, Head, Department of English and Dr. G. Sujatha Head, Department of Tamil began the bridge course with an ice breaking session on 18.06.2018. On the second day 19. 06.2018, Ms.J. Josephine Mary, taught the students basic grammar skills which was followed by a session on Letter Writing, handled by Mrs. R. Sarathy, Asst.Prof., Dept. of English. The third day of the Bridge Course,(20.06.2018) began with a visit to the library. The librarian, Dr.J.Shanthi took the students around the library and addressed the students on the importance of the reading habit and the various programmes conducted by the library in association with the Tamil Department and Online Courses. After the visit, the faculty members of the Tamil Department addressed the students on life ethics, the problems generally faced by college students and core family values. The concluding session of the Bridge Course was a motivational one. Ms. V.P.Gayathri, Asst.Prof & Head, Dept.of English addressed the students on issues of self-confidence, the entrepreneurial spirit, dealing with failure in a positive manner and the importance of remaining grounded in the family.

The Department of English organized (Unaided) “The Bridge course” for the first year of all the departments from 18 to 20th of June 2018.



On 18.06.2018 began at 1.30. p.m. in the concern department class rooms. Faculties of English Department directed them towards the core value of the college like respecting elders, paying attention to their studies and being polite towards the faculty. Then they learn how to introduce themselves in a formal and informal way. On 19.06.2018 Faculties of English Department taught the students basic grammar which was followed by smart class room training to gain knowledge about the sounds of English language “Phonetic”.
