REPORT OF THE PROGRAMME

Devi, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Zoology, Dr. M. Nagarathinam, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Chemistry, Dr. G. Sujatha Assistant Professor & Department of Tamil, Dr. J. Shanthi Librarian, D.K.M College for Women. The prayer was led by Mrs. S. Sumathi, Assistant Professor, Department of English, which was followed by the traditional lighting of the Lamp by the distinguished Guests. Mrs. M .Gayathri, Assistant Professor, Department of English welcomed the gathering. Dr. K. Devi, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Zoology delivered the inauguration address requesting the participants to Mrs. R. Sarathy, Assistant Professor, Department of English Mastered the ceremony. Events like Literary Quiz, Poster Presentation, Lit Ramp , Vignettes from the Bard and Stage a Poem were organized .

A large number of students participated from different educational institutions .As a part of inter collegiate competition a literary quiz was led by Mrs. S.
