CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Details of the Curriculum Changes in syllabus during 2019-20 (about 500 words):

DEPARTMENT OF TAMIL:

B.A. Tamil Stands for Bachelor of Arts in Tamil It is one of the oldest and well known undergraduate academic programs in the world. The Course will also allow the aspirants to educate themselves regarding the grammar and vocabulary aspects of the Language.

Below mentioned are some of the subjects included in the syllabus

- Grammar and its importance
- History of Tamil Language
- The recent changes in the Language
- The Concept of root Language

The B.A. Tamil course is considered to be a flexible course that permits the student to choose a course which is the best match for their career interest. In the arts subjects there is no restriction regarding the selection of specialization which is not the case of the others specialized fields. The course will impart the general as well as the vital skills to the candidates, which support the future career aspirations.

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH:

The B.A English syllabus has been changed from CBCS pattern to OBE pattern. The First two semester papers have been modified and approved through the academic council. The following B.A English subjects have been modified up to 80%. The Core papers of 1st Semester 19CEN1A British Fiction and 19CEN1B British Poetry have undergone few updated contents in various units. The allied paper Literary Forms, Terms and Movements have also been modified. Similarly the changes have been brought in 2nd Semester B.A English syllabus in both core and allied papers American Literature, Indian Writing in English and Socio-Cultural History of England respectively.

The M.A English syllabus was also changed from CBCS pattern to OBE pattern. The First two semester papers have been modified and approved through the academic council. The following M.A English subjects have been modified up to 80%.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY:

The department has adopted a new curriculum that uses the new methodology of teaching Outcome Based Education (OBE). This process helps to create a learning environment that supports the learning activities appropriate to achieving the desired learning outcomes.

The changes in the curriculum help the students to create thirst in critical thinking, analyzing and problem solving skills. It creates knowledge in promising areas of chemical sciences and to motivate the students to pursue their future studies. It develops the activity in understanding and applying the principles of Chemistry. It equips with the skills to compete for competitive examinations and to find employment in various sectors.

DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS:

As the old syllabus is as per the requirements and guidelines of TANSCH, only slight modification is made in the syllabus. The students must learn core subjects in mathematics like

Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus and Solid Geometry to understand math on a deeper level and enhance their knowledge and skills. These subjects are necessary to master and to excel in mathematics. The content is modified to OBE pattern. In the subject Allied –Mathematical Statistics I, the topic curvilinear Regression and Regression curves were included. In the subject allied – Mathematical Statistics II, the topic F- distribution, Constants, Mode and Points of inflexion of F- distribution were included.

Introduced an important topic Index Numbers in Unit 5 instead of Analysis of Variance in an Elective paper of Business Mathematics and Statistics II for I BBA Students. This topic helps the students to get through various competitive exams and to use statistical tools in business and arrive at possible inferences relating to population under study. In P.G Syllabus, we included the Self Study paper with extra credit in the first and third Semester and optional online course was introduced for final year P.G students. Also introduced a new paper Differential Geometry instead of Tensor Analysis and Relativity in second Semester for I M.Sc Mathematics. It has wide number of applications in various fields like Physics, Geology, image processing and computer vision and Biology etc., and also this paper is very useful for the students to prepare the SET exam.

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE:

INNOVATIONS IN CURRICULUM

During the academic year 2019 20 our Department introduced Out Come Based Education Model to the curriculum. The syllabus was modified according to the Current Employability Scenario. The Syllabus was framed based on syllabus based on TANSCHÉ, UGC and Thiruvalluvar University. The Templates and first year syllabus were approved by the Board of Studies and Academic Council. The following modifications inclusions were made to suit the employability market.

B Com I semester-Financial Accounting-I is a needed subject in day today life. 80% of the syllabus was modified, namely, the topics Rectification of Errors were introduced, alterations were made in Final accounts and Depreciation and Fire Insurance were clubbed. With regard to Business organization subject only 40% was modified as the previous syllabus covered the required topics. Unit-1 and V were modified.

B Com II semester- Financial Accounting-II includes all the required topics to suit the existing scenario. So the changes were not introduced. With regard of Business Communication some internal rearrangement was made to cover the topics much needed to the present employable scenario.

B Com (CA) I semester-Financial Accounting-I and **B Com (CA) II semester**- Financial Accounting-II syllabus are adopted as framed for B Com –General.

M Com I Semester- Advanced Financial Management. The syllabus was modified / changed to nearly 60%.Unit-I, Unit-II and Unit-III was modified to suit the UGC Net Syllabus. Marketing management was fully updated with the requirements of the UGC Net Syllabus. Advanced Business Statistics was modified to the extent of 60% to topics required to prepare for UGC Net. New subject with nomenclature Dynamics of Banking was introduced. This syllabus also was prepared according to the UGC Net.

M Com II Semester Human Resource Management syllabus was modified by introducing important topics namely, Training and Development, Career Planning and development and introduced recent trends in HRM. Advanced Accounts syllabus was modified with reference to UGC Net Syllabus. Basics were not included. Only advanced topics were included namely, Amalgamation and Absorption, Alteration of share capital and Internal reconstruction, Liquidation and Banking Company which are very important to employable scenario. Quantitative Techniques syllabus was modified with introducing Quantitative techniques and Network analysis.

DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY:

The Board approved the Outcome Based Education syllabus for UG zoology first and second semester for the candidate admitted from 2019 - 2020 onwards. The board resolved to elaborate basic Taxonomy in unit 1 of core paper – Invertebrate of UG zoology. We included the Economic Importance for the entire Phylum in I and II semester papers to inculcate the significance and importance of studying systemic zoology among the young minds.

It has approved the syllabus framed for PG zoology 1st and 2nd semester for the academic year 2019- 2020 onwards. It also approved to introduce an optional paper – self study or any online course during 1st and 3rd semester which will carry 2 credits .we have chosen Organic Farming as self study paper in the I semester and Mushroom Cultivation in the III semester of PG. They also are doing their online course in NPTEL-Biomedical Nanotechnology in their III semester as self study papers.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS:

The Board attempted a mild churning and shuffling with Indian Economy syllabus. Roughly 30% of the syllabus has been changed. National Income is introduced in lieu of Labour economics. The logic behind the change is to give a big picture in a wider canvass of wages and other incomes. More thrust is also given for an elaborate study of an industry such as micro, medium and large industry. It is to enable the students to get a bird's eye view about the industry and its growth strategy. The topic on NITIYAYOG and its functioning are also a part of this syllabus.

DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY:

New template and syllabus was framed as per UGC Norms and Outcome Based curriculum. The syllabuses mainly concentrated on the topics were covered by UGC Net, UPSC and TNPSC. To prepare them to face the competitive examination.

For I B.A., History I Semester the title was changed for the core paper – I History of India up to 1000A.D and core –II History of India from 1000 A.D. to 1526 A.D. In the II Semester the title was changed for core paper III as History of India from 1526 A.D.to 1707A.D.and for core paper IV the title had changed as History of India from 1707 A.D to 1857 A.D. The syllabus was framed to give significance to major historical events.100% change was introduced.

In MA History Programme no Changes were made in the Syllabus during in the academic year - 2019 - 20. Geography of India with special reference to Tamil Nadu was included self study paper to enable the students to understand Natural resources. Created course objective, outcome knowledge level, mapping with programming outcomes in effective manner.

DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES:

Outcome based education is a model of education that rejects the traditional way of teaching the students. It focuses on making the students to improve their knowledge and to make them understand the subjects. OBE education system is measured in terms of outcomes rather than inputs. With this motive we at the Department of Management Studies have done the following changes in the subjects introduced for the first and second semester subjects of BBA, B.Sc. ISM, and MA HRM.

DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY:

Department of Biochemistry introduced a solid foundation in Biology and chemistry, and to develop analytical and critical –thinking skills for **UG Biochemistry**, it allows independent exploration of Biological phenomenon through the scientific methods. As a part of it “ Cell Biology” is the major paper in 1st semester in which students themselves are aware of different types of Cells, tissues, organs and its function and Bio-Organic Chemistry in 2nd semester, in which students learn the Basics of Bio molecule and their significant functions, and main practical consist of both Cell Biology and Biochemistry Experiments. In the similar way **Allied Biochemistry** students learn basics - the structure and function of Bio molecules, and Analytical Biochemistry-II syllabus was introduced in such a way the students gain the knowledge about the working principle and applications of various biochemical techniques.

PG Biochemistry syllabus was modified to train students with good scientific and technical knowledge so as to comprehend, analyze, design, and create novel products and solutions for developing novel therapeutics - three core paper namely Analytical Biochemistry, Human Physiology & Nutritional Biochemistry, and Bio molecules, elective paper Molecular Biology

for first semester. Enzymology , Intermediary Metabolism, Ecology, Evolution & proteomics as a core paper Plant Biochemistry and Developmental biology as elective paper for second semester along with three practical's, **Self study paper**, Nutraceuticals and Nutrigenomics for first semester and Health Care Management for the second semester was also introduced in the syllabus.

DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY:

The Objective based education was introduced for both the UG and PG first year students from the academic year 2019-2020 onwards. The Objective based Syllabus was reframed according to the UGC Syllabus. The Programme Objectives and Outcomes, Course Objectives and Outcomes were framed for the each paper. The course outcomes were framed for each Unit of the paper. Mapping of Course outcomes with the Programme outcomes were also made in the syllabus. Self study paper was introduced in the M.Sc Microbiology syllabus in the I and III Semester, Organic farming was introduced in the I semester and Laboratory Animal Science in the III Semester. In B. Sc Microbiology the Fermentation Microbiology in the VI Semester was replaced with a new paper Microbial Biotechnology. The Syllabus was approved by the Board of Studies and Academic council members.

DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY:

The syllabus of UG and PG Biotechnology has been changed from CBCS pattern to OBE pattern completely. Based on outcome based curriculum the template for UG and PG Biotechnology was prepared for the academic year 2019-20 has been approved with few suggestions. The syllabus for UG and PG Biotechnology for I and II semesters prepared for the academic year 2019-20 has been approved. Self study papers were included in I and II semester which are optional and extra 2 credits has been allotted for each subject. Core and elective papers have to be framed based on the criteria- medical, environmental, agricultural and industrial biotechnology. Include the recent edition text books and references. Introduction to value added courses for PG Students. Evolution and diversity of life can be made as self study instead of bioinstrumentation which is made as core.

DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND APPLICATION:

During 2019-2020 Outcome Based Education Curriculum Design followed. Template revised for B.Sc. Computer Science, B.C.A., and M.Sc. Computer Science. In B.Sc., Computer Science and BCA, Digital logic and Programming in C, a new paper is introduced instead of Digital Logic / IT. In B.Sc., Computer Science and BCA, C++ and Data Structure, a new paper which was a Third Semester Paper replaced to Second semester with the programming code U18 instead of Programming in C. Enterprise Java Programming, a new paper has been introduced to PG M.Sc Computer Science. Big Data, a new paper has been introduced to PG M.Sc Computer Science as a Elective Paper. Optional Online Course and Self Study Paper, a new paper (with optional extra 2 credits) has been introduced.

DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND NUTRITION:

For the academic year 2019-2020, Department of Nutrition, Food Service Management and Dietetics, UG program code U27, the Allied paper - Food Microbiology as a new paper with the 100 % of syllabus content added. Food Microbiology paper, students learn about various microorganisms in food and its food spoilage. Methods to preserve food by various techniques also learned. For the PG Foods and nutrition with P18 program code, Elective paper Communication and diet counseling- a new paper with the 100% of syllabus content added. This paper induces knowledge in teaching aids used dietitians, counseling and educating patient.

For the PG Foods and Nutrition with P18 program code, two optional self-study papers – a new paper with the 100% of syllabus content added. Research funding agencies and proposal writing for grants and fellowship is learned by students.

DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY:

The Syllabus of B.Sc Psychology has been changed from CBCS pattern to OBE pattern completely. The template was modified with changes brought in hours and credits. First two semester subjects have been modified and approved during Academic Council. The paper Psychological Statistics was renamed as Research and Statistics in Psychology where in 2 units of Research Methodology has replaced Statistics. For all the odd and even semester subjects, the theory and practicum was introduced. III Semester Learning Disability paper was removed and replaced it with Positive Psychology. Marketing and Advertising and Consumer Behavior were clubbed as Consumer Psychology in IV Semester. School Counseling and Environmental Psychology papers were interchanged between IV and V Semester. Health and Wellbeing was introduced as even semester Non Major Elective. Cyber Psychology was introduced as V Semester Skill Based Paper. HRM was renamed as Psychology in HRM and Skill Based paper Life Skills Development was renamed as Life Skills Education. No Changes has been brought in Basic Psychology, Developmental and Educational Psychology in I B.Sc Psychology OBE Syllabus.
