REPORT ON STREET THEATRE TRAINING PROGRAMMER

A oneday Training program was organized in D.K.M. College for Women by **Audacious Dreams Foundation** in association with English Department. Ms. M. Angelin Mercy, Assistant Professor of English Welcomed the gathering and lead the session. The objective of this program is to promote “**Therukoothu**” an ancient art form among young people as a medium to create social thoughts and messages. The program started at 9.30 a.m., with **Mr.Dinesh Gajendran**, Calalyst and Executive Director of Audacious Dreams Foundation as a Chief Guest.
