

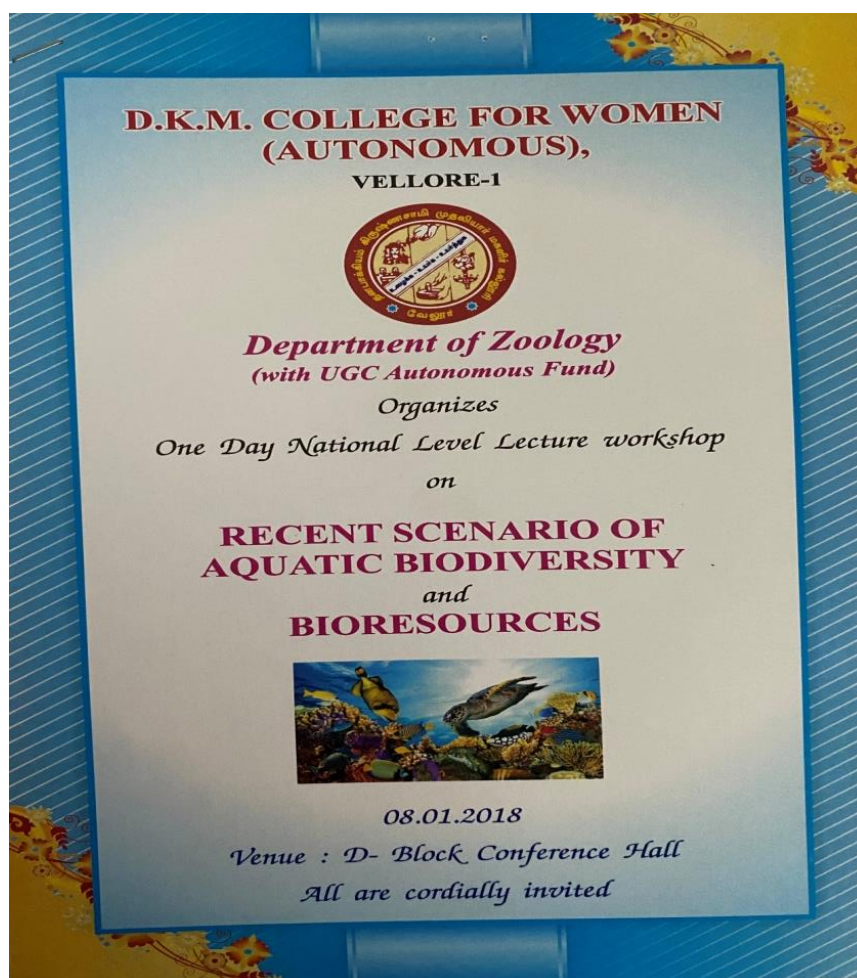

The Department of Zoology has organized one day national level Lecture Workshop on the topic **”Recent scenario on Aquatic Biodiversity and Bioresources”** on 08.01.2018 with the UGC Autonomous Fund. More than 350 participants attended the workshop including 200 UG Zoology, PG Zoology, Microbiology, Biotechnology and Research Scholars of our College. The out side participants are from Thiruvalluvar University Vellore, Voorhees College Vellore, Arignar Anna Government Arts and Science College for Women Walajapet, Muthurangam Government Arts College Vellore, Government Thirumagal Mills College Gudiyattam and Islamiah College Vaniyambadi. The Programme started with registration at 9 am, followed with the inauguration at 10 am commenced with prayer song by the students. The chief guest and all the dignitaries lighted the kuthuvillakku. The gatherings were welcomed by Dr. K. Devi, HOD of Zoology. Felicitation was given by our college Secretary Mr. D. Maninathan and our Principal Dr. P. N. Sudha. The chief guest Dr. T.T.
