



PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES:


- To share knowledge about Intellectual Property Rights and its legal procedures.
- To produce patents and copyrights in the educational level.


REPORT OF THE PROGRAMME:

Knowing the importance of Intellectual property rights and its impact on India's economic and intellectual growth Institutional Innovation Council of DKM College for Women in collaboration with the government of India has organized a webinar on "INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY **RIGHTS**" on 11.03.2022 from 11.00 A.M. to 12.30 P.M. for the students of D.K.M College for Women. The programme was organized in Google Meet platform and also streamed in YouTube. 100 participants took part in Google Meet and around 106 faculty and 381 Students including the faculty from various departments of the college participated in You Tube Streaming. Prof. A.Amirthavalli, IIC president, D.K.M. College for Women presided the session and introduced the importance of the webinar. Dr.A.Aruna Devi, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry introduced the resource person of the day. Mr. Hari Prasad, Examiner of patents and designs, Chennai. In this session, MR. HARIPRASATH, EXAMINER OF PATENTS & DESIGNS from chennai delivered a practical lecture on the importance of Patents, Copyrights, Trademark, Registered Designs and Geographical indications. He gave a simple understanding of the related terms of patent rights by giving examples of the products people use in daily life. He shed light on the importance of registration, utilization and commercialization of the products people create.


He pointed out the difference License, Franchise and Merchandising of the new products people create. He quoted different examples like Mcdonalds, Poorvika, Mysore sandal soap and Michael Jackson's shoes to make students understand the differences between the terms. He helped the students in understanding the importance of making new patents by citing India's position in the patent registerations. There was also a explanation on the procedures in filing of IPR at the end of the session along with a quiz for the better understanding of the topic.


SCREENSHOTS OF THE PROGRAMME
