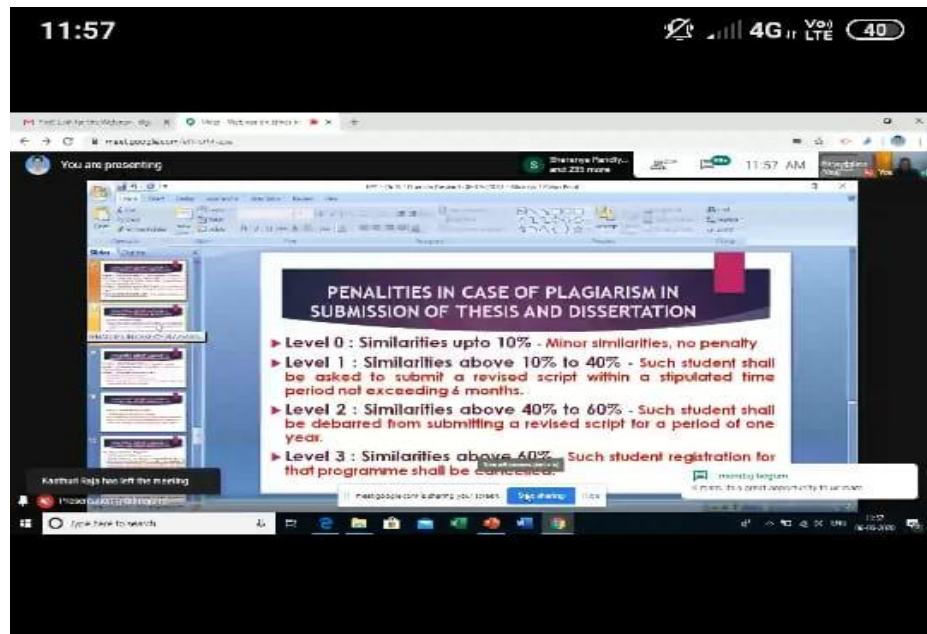
It was a very informative session which helped everyone imbibes knowledge about the Research Ethics.
