Following this the Chief Gust delivered his speech .He gave a vivid lecture on the Qualities of Great Women in Tamil Nadu. He explained the Nangili Movement; First Women Freedom fighter Velu Nachiyar She was the first Indian queen to wage war with the East India Company in India. She is known by Tamils as Veeramangai Kuili is known for her suicide attack in 1780.

He also delivered lecture on the role played by Govindammal who was the first women Regiment in the INA created by Netaji Subash Chandra Bose.

Anjali Ammal was a social worker and reformer from Kadalur. Anjalai Ammal she started her political activism in 1921 with the Non-Cooperation Movement and later took part in the Neil Statue Satyagraha, Salt Satyagraha and Quit India Movement. Her courage was so well known that Mahathma Gandhi called her South India's Jhansi Rani.

Ambujammal Desikachari was an Indian independence activist and women's rights activist. She participated in the Civil Disobedience Movement and served as Vice_President of the Tamil_Nadu Congress Committee. Ambujammal was awarded the <u>Padma Shri</u> in 1964. He said their contribution is most important to achieve our independence. They are the pioneer of Independence movement.

He also advised the students to be strong, bold, brave, be responsible citizen positive attitude, overcome obstacles, strong-minded, soft-hearted.

150 students from .U.G and P.G attended the meeting, they came to know about our Great Women freedom fighters of India .The meeting came to an end with National Anthem. Vote of thanks was given by Mrs. S.Jayanthi Assistant Professor of History.
