College for Women had organized an awareness programme "Innovation in startups" on 28.06.2023 D-Block conference in hall 10.00 on at a.m. Mr. S. Rajesh Kumar, District Executive Officer, Vaazhndhu Kaatuvom Project (VKP-TNRTP), Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, District Project Management Unit District, (DPMU), Ranipet acted as a resource person. He delivered a lecture on the topic, "Innovation in startups".
