

To honour womanhood, Department of Mathematics, D.K.M College for Women has decided to celebrate the International Women's day on 8th march 2022 in our D.K.M College with the encouragement of our beloved Secretary Er.D.Maninathan, President Dr.T.Sivakumar and Principal Dr.P.N.Sudha. For this event the Guest of honour was Mrs.J.Abarna, Inspector of Police, Crime branch, Vellore.

The event started with the blessings of our Almighty. After the silent prayer Mrs.G.Vinupriya, Assistant Professor and Head(Day), Department of Mathematics honoured the chief guest with a shawl. The event was hosted by Mrs.C.Revathi, Assistant Professor of Mathematics in a lively manner. Mrs.R.Ramya, Assistant Professor and Head(Evening), Department of Mathematics welcomed the gathering. Introduction of the Chief guest was given by Dr.B.Vijayalakshmi. It was a proud occasion to have our distinguished alumni as resource person.

Chief guest Mrs.J.Abarna addressed the gathering on "Cyber Crime Awareness". She insisted the students must know how to defend themselves and be careful about the crimes against women. Especially she gave a vivid explanation about what is cybercrime and how the young women are affected in social media. She detailed some cybercrimes which were done against women. She explained about the Harassment through e-mails, Cyber staking, Cyber defamation, Child pornography, Cyber grooming. Her speech was an eye opener for many of our students. Around 335 Students from the Department of Mathematics, Computer science, Business Administration and Eight Faculty members of Mathematics are benefited through this event. After her speech, she distributed pamphlets to students, to create awareness about cybercrime. The pamphlet contains the list of some common techniques and tools employed by the cyber criminals. Some of them are,

• Using fake customer care number to get personal account details from the people.

- Misusing personal information which were collected from Facebook, Instagram, etc. (identity theft)
- Through fake website, made the people to send money using internet banking.
- Targeting gamers with fake game updates or utilities climbing to customize their game for money.
- Form of advertisements or spam emails that include promises of rewards or offers of unrealistic amounts of money.
- Sending miscellaneous email attachment or URLs to users to gain access to their account.
- Cyber stalking: This involves online harassment where the user is subjected to plethora of online messages and emails.

After the distribution of pamphlets vote of thanks was given by Dr.T.Ranjani, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics. Finally, the event ended with National Anthem. Feedback was collected from all the participants. This programme was the great opportunity for the faculties and participants to create awareness about cybercrime.
