Report of One Day Workshop on” Care of laboratory Animals in Accordance with Ethical Guidelines for Research”

On 30th January 2024, A One-day National level workshop on “Care of laboratory Animals in Accordance with Ethical Guidelines for Research” was organized by DKMCFRI and Department of Biochemistry, Microbiology and Biotechnology, DKM College for Women (Autonomous) Vellore-1. The programme was inaugurated in D Block Conference hall at 10.30 am. Dr. A.Vidhya, Head and Assistant Professor of Microbiology, Member Secretary IAEC, welcomed the participants. Dr. R.Baumathy, Principal, DKM College, Vellore, felicitated the gathering. Dr. S. Vinodhini, Head and Assistant professor of the Biotechnology Department, introduced the resource person to the gathering.

Dr. Soosai Manickam Amirtham gave a detailed explanation about caring the laboratory animals in accordance with ethical guidelines for research was essential for ensuring their welfare and respecting their rights. The attendees were brought to an animal home for practical training following a brief informational session. There are two groups formed out of the participants. The primary topics of this workshop will be lab animal care and usage, minimal ethical consideration, care and practice standards for research and institutions, lab animal treatment, handling, drug administration routes, etc. The participants also answered, engaged in conversation, and discovered that managing animals requires training, abilities, etc.

The programme concluded with a valedictory session led by Dr. R. Banumathy, Principal of DKM College for Women, along with staffs of Biochemistry, Microbiology and Biotechnology departments, well as a resource person. The students distributed workshop certificates and offered their enthusiastic opinions. The vote of gratitude was given by Dr. V. Prabha, the head and assistant professor of Biochemistry. The one-day workshop benefited 98 scholars and students from different colleges in and around Vellore, including UG and PG students from the Department of Biochemistry, Microbiology, and Biotechnology at DKM College for Women.
