REPORT ON “POLYCYSTIC OVARIAN SYNDROME”

The "Awareness Programme on Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome" will be held on September 1, 2023, from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM in the D Block Conference Hall of D.K.M. College for Women (Autonomous), Vellore, conducted by PG and Research Department of Biochemistry and Microbiology. The performance of "Silent prayer" began the programme. Dr. B. Hebsibah Elsie, an assistant professor in the department of biochemistry, greeted everyone in attendance as well as the primary guest with sincere greetings.

The session is then handed over to the principal guest, Dr. K. MANJULA, M.S(OG), MRCOG Consultant Obstetrician & Gynaecologist, Katpadi, Infertility Specialist, following the opening remarks. The presentation made clear that early detection and better health-seeking behavior depend on PCOS knowledge.
