#### **July 28 World Hepatitis Day**

Most people living with hepatitis are unaware of their infection. What's more, chronic viral hepatitis is the most common risk factor for liver cancer. By increasing awareness, many deaths can be prevented.

Hepatitis A is typically transmitted through the ingestion of contaminated water and food or contact with someone carrying the infection. Hepatitis A is most likely to be found in people who...

- Have not been vaccinated or previously infected
- Live in areas with poor sanitation and/or a lack of safe drinking water
- Live with infected persons
- Use drugs recreationally
- Have a sexual partner who has hepatitis A

Hepatitis B & C are most likely to be found in people who...

- Are sexually active but are not in monogamous, long-term relationships
- Have HIV
- Have a close family member or mother with hepatitis B
- Live with someone who has hepatitis B
- Are men who have sex with men
- Work in healthcare and may be exposed to blood
- Inject illicit drugs
- Have chronic kidney or liver disease
- Have tattoos and/or piercings that may have been infected
- Work in healthcare and might experience needle-stick accidents
- Were born to mothers with HCV
