The details of various events that were conducted in the induction program were as follows.

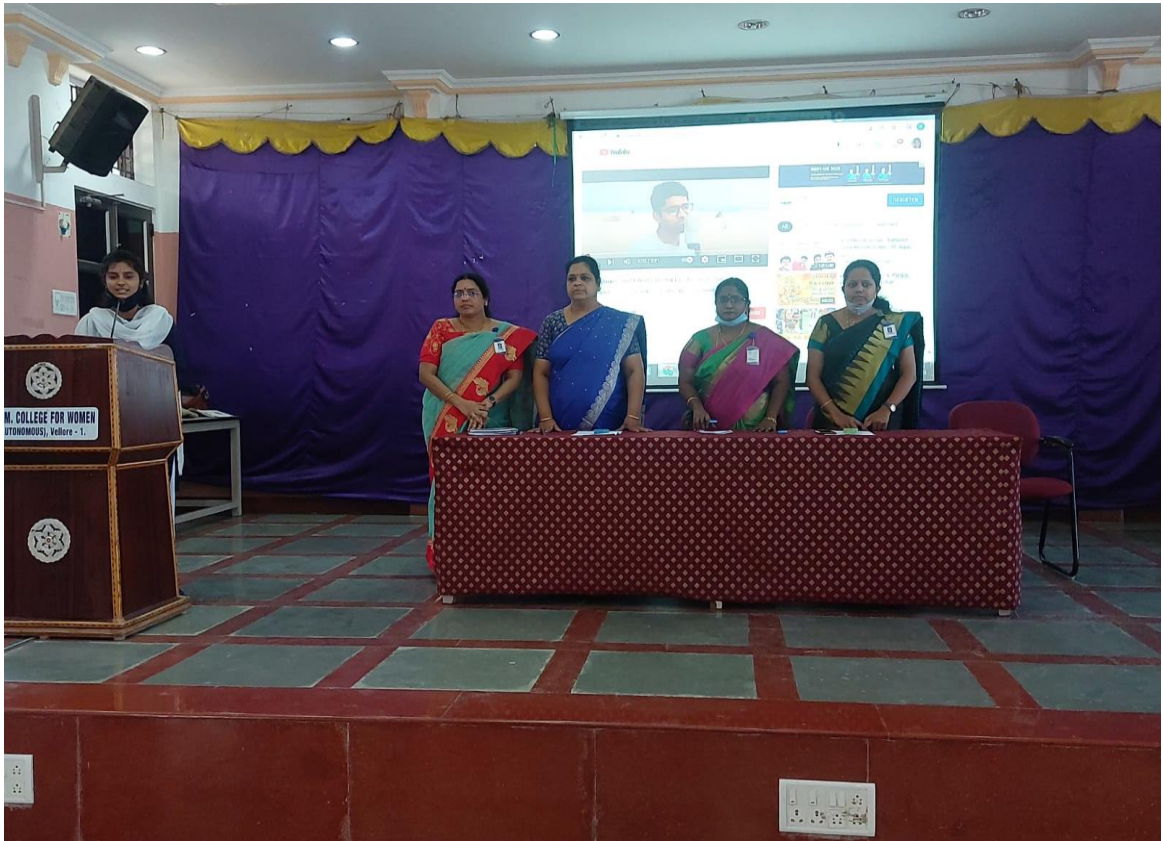
## **Day 1: 7.11.2021**
