After having breakfast in hotel we went to Thumba, Equatorial Rocket Launching Station (TERLS) Thiruvananthapuram is an Indian spaceport established on 1963 operated by Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) for launching sounding rockets. Head of the space Museum explained about the types of rockets, how satellites are launching with the help of rockets. As students are studying science and technology paper it is informative for the students.

Next students visited National History Museum at 1.00p.m. There students admired about beauty of the different types of creatures of animals, birds, Insects and reptiles. After that we went to Padmanaba Temple in Thiruvananthapuram at 4.00p.m. There students able to understand the architectural beauty of the Travancore ruler. We stayed at Jumayira International Hotel, Beach Road, kovalam. Next Day on 13.10.2023 Early morning at 6.00a.m we visited Kovalam Beach; students enjoyed the beauty of the nature and Beach. After having breakfast in the same hotel we went to Poovar Back Water Boating, Poovar is famous for its undisturbed natural beauty, where we can view the

confluence of the Neyyar River, lake, Back Water and the Sea. Students really enjoyed beauty of this place.

Finally students went to Vivekanandha Rock in Kanyakumari at 4.30p.m. Students could see the great saint Vivekanda's mediation place and also feet of Kanyakumari. After that we winded up our tour and proceed to Vellore. We reached our college safely at 10.30a.m.
